- Ability to bend, squat, push/pull 30 pounds as needed to assist with therapy services

Summary of Essential Job Functions of the Board Certified Behavior Analyst:

1. Conducting assessment activities related to the need for behavioral interventions;
2. Designing, executing and monitoring behavioral analysis and therapy treatment programs;
3. Overseeing implementation of behavioral analysis programs by other Company employees (i.e. supervision of RBT's and those working toward that credential)
4. Training, designing behavioral systems, and performance management;
5. Implementation of behavior analytic assessments, interventions, training, and supervision in both remote/telehealth sessions and clinic-based settings
6. Facilitating parent meetings/ parent training to ensure consistency between the home and clinic;

7. Completing comprehensive goals for Clients and completing reports for all necessary documentation requirements related to reimbursement from insurance companies and for review by Clients;
8. Completing an accurate weekly log of all billable interactions and billable Service hours for the Client chart and reporting all information to Company;
9. Working collaboratively with other professionals involved in Client's case;
10. Staying current with research and new methodologies
11. Other activities generally performed by a BCBA that are directly related to behavioral analysis such as activities related to oversight of Company programs and employees.
